Where it hisses, bubbles and the mountains spewing fire

The north of the Indonesian island Sulawesi shows you a different, unfamiliar side: two seas, white-water rivers, waterfalls, evergreen rainforests, scented flower-filled meadows, rice fields, active volcanoes, national parks and in the middle the Lake Tondano.

These fertile volcanic embossed highlands are called Minahasa. There is a lot to discover for Caroline and Thomas. They plan to go in the afternoon to the lake Tondano to do some kayak. They also heard that the Mountain View Resort in Tomohon has clean bungalows and an excellent restaurant. The list of activities they're offering for their guests is long.

During the trekking tour to the active crater of Lokon-Empung twin volcano, Caroline and Thomas enjoying a fantastic view of the highlands and the Bunaken Marine National Park with his five different islands. Learn about the geology and how the people at the foot of the Mountain of Fire with its frequent eruptions cope.

Diaphoretic but worthwhile in any case their tour to the 80 meters high Tinoor waterfalls. As compensation take a bath in the hot springs, surrounded by rice fields.

In the village Rurukan they try organically grown strawberries and taking some photographs of the Klabat volcano, which is the highest peak in North Sulawesi with his 1,995 meters. In the potters in Pulutan they showcase their craftsmanship and are consistent in Kawangkoan with specialties around the peanut.

The highland coffee at lake Linow tastes especially good with the overlooking at the shimmering (in different shades of green) water surface. At the end they visit Woloan where the typical Minahasa wooden houses are made of eager carpenters.

Wellness in Mountain View Resort is announced before the Minahasa menu is served in the resort's restaurant with a bottle of good wine.

In the tour map of the resort the two adventurers discover something very special - Whitewater Rafting on a jungle river. No matter what is written on their holiday program for tomorrow.
